Fees & Charges from September 2020

BABY CARE For Babies aged from 6 weeks.

Open Daily: 7am – 6pm

Places are booked and invoiced monthly.

All fees are payable a month in hand on receipt of invoice

Minimum Requirement: 2 sessions of 7 hours weekly.

Prices include homemade Baby lunch daily. All milk feeds and nappies etc., are to be provided by parents to ensure children's individual needs are appropriately met.

TODDLER CARE: For mobile children to 3 years of age.

The Ducklings Room: 7am-6pm daily

Minimum Requirement: 2 sessions of 7 hours weekly.

Prices includes cooked lunch, snacks and teas daily, and full Enrichment Programme.

(All nappies etc to be provided by parents)

BUTTERFLY DEPARTMENT:

For children of 2 years (walking) to Pre School

Open Term Time only: Wednesdays, Thursdays and Fridays 8am-6pm. (38 weeks of the year)

Minimum Requirement: 2 sessions of 5 hours weekly

For parents who require funded sessions ONLY

Children who qualify for 2 year old funding can attend Wednesday, Thursday & Friday 3x5 hrs (15 hours) from 8am-1pm or 1pm-6pm These sessions are funded by Nursery Education Funding (NEF) currently £5.28 per hour. (£78.00 per week)

Children who qualify for 3 & 4 year old funding for only 15 hours can attend on Wednesday, Thursday, Friday for 5 hrs (8am-1pm, or 1pm-6pm) or 10 hours (8am-6pm). NEF currently £4.20 per hour.

Children who qualify for 3 & 4 year old funding for 30 hours attend Wednesday, Thursday and Friday from 8am-6pm (3 x 10 hours)

The Butterfly Enrichment Programme includes all meals and extras. These Chargeable Elements are due for all 3 & 4 year olds as follows:

5 hour session (8am-1pm)incl lunch £11.00

5 hour session (1pm-6pm)incl tea £ 8.00

10 hour session (8am-6pm)incl lunch & tea £20.00

Starter Sessions for new children

8am-1pm (Short Day) 5 hours incl lunch £38.00

8am-6pm (Long Day) 10hours incl lunch £64.00

(Available Wednesdays, Thursdays and Fridays ONLY)

Government Funding can be used for starter sessions.

All children enjoy free milk drinks and nutritional cooked meals, prepared by our Specialist Catering Team.

NURSERY (Robins) & PRE-SCHOOL (Barn Owls) & FOREST SCHOOL GROUP

For toilet trained children from 30 months - 5 years of age.

Open from 7am-6pm all year.

Minimum Requirement: Nursery (Robin) at least 2

sessions weekly/Pre School (Barn Owl) at least 3 sessions weekly/Forest School at least 2 sessions weekly.

Early Bird starts (including breakfast)

7am-8am £11.00

7.30am-8am £ 7.50

Includes all meals, snacks, milk and full Enrichment Programme (Details below).

8am-3pm (Short Day) 7 hours £50.00

8am-6pm (Long Day) 10 hours £64.00

Additional Emergency Hour £ 8.50

Weekly Government Funding for 3 & 4 year olds:

15 hrs allocation per week £47.25

30 hrs allocation per week £94.50

Government Funding:

In the term following a child's 3rd birthday, Government Funding (NEF) for 15 hours weekly in term time (stretched over 12 months) is automatically claimed for all children. Where both parents are working and other conditions are met, some children will qualify for 30 hours weekly (stretched over 12 months). These values are detailed above and will automatically be applied to your monthly invoices. For parents who only require term time only places, please see the Butterfly Department.

Pupil Premium and Special Needs Funding will also be applied for according to individual circumstances.

ENRICHMENT PROGRAMME

This includes all cooked meals, snacks, milk and drinks, sleep room bedding and laundry, cookery and ingredients, pet care, clamber club and gym time, drama and dance, Woodland & Forest School activities, Singing and Music with specialist teacher, visits, outings and excursions. (See calendar) plus enhanced staff ratios and ongoing professional qualifications and training.

AFTER SCHOOL CARE: Operates during term time for school aged children who are collected after school and transported back to the Centre.

(Charged daily – including cooked tea & activities, collection & transport from school).

Collection from school until 6pm £24.00

Children delivered to the Centre

independently 3-6pm £16.50

SCHOOL HOLIDAY PLAY SCHEMES:

For school aged children (Aged 4-12 years). All children will enjoy a daily cooked lunch.

9am-3pm (Short Day) 6 hours £38.00

9am-6pm (Long Day) 9 hours £49.00

8am-9am Early Bird Hour £ 6.50

7am-8am Early Bird Hour £10.00
